



Henry Moomaw was the son of 221 John and Anna Barbara Ranck Moomaw. He was born in 1791 after the family left Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, and moved to Botetourt County, Virginia.

According to tradition he road alone on horsback from Virginia to Ross Co. Ohio, where his brother John (vol 1 p.6) and his sister Barbara Beath had come a few years before.

Here he met and soon married Ann Gray, the daughter of the first school teacher in Twin township.





Henry and his brother-in-law Joseph Beath were chain carriers for Cadwalader Wallace when he surveyed for himself survey number 3568 on part of a militery warrant no. 6095. This part of Ohio was in the Virginia Military District. Virginia gave warrents of survey to soldiers who had fought in the Virginia Line in the Revolution. These Warrents were negotiable, and most were bought by land speculators who hired surveyors to locate the lands for them. The surveyor took his fee in a percentage of the land.

This survey begins, "at a hicory in the Northwesterly line of a tract of land whereon Joseph Beath now lives"

Henry later bought part of survey 12388 from Mr. Wallace and Survey 8568 from Henry Stitt.

A few years later the rest  $\infty$  of the family except Christian and Philip came to Ohio.

John Sr. bought 150 acres survey 8319 and 55 acres of survey 2760, In 1816 he and Barbara sold 50 acres to their daughter Elizabeth. In 1821 they sold 100 acres to Jacob.

In 1824 Jacob of Clark Co. and his wife Elizabeth(Omart) sold this 100 acres to his brother David. David also bought from his father 17½ Acres of the other piece. Leaving John and Barbara with just 37 acres.

In 1830 Eva Fisher, a widow with three children are apperently living with John and Barbara.

On the 5th of April 1834

John signed his will with an x
even though he had signed the earlier deeds. It was witnessed by
Peter Snyder and Joseph Rockhold, who propaly wrote it as he was
an early Justice of the Peace in the area. We must remember that
John grew up in a German speaking area, so his English would have
had a heavy German accent.

He did not mention his wife in the will altho she was still alive. After the usual preamble he said, "I give unto my son Christian Moomaw the sum of one dollar and to my son John Moomaw the sum of one dollar and to my daughter Elizabeth Moomaw the sum of one dollar and to my daughter Mary Magdelan Snyder the sum of one dollar and to my son Phillip Moomaw the sum of one dollar and to my daughter Barbary Beath the sum of one dollar and to my son David Moomaw the sum of one dollar and to my daughter Christiana Ploughterthe sum of one dollar and to my son Henry Moomaw the sum of one dollar and to my son Jacob Moomaw the sum of one dollar and to my daughter Miggel omit the sum of one dollar(did he mean Margaret Omart) and to my daughter Eve Fisher the hole of the remainder of all my estate both real and personal. And lastly I do hearby appoint my daughter Eve Fisher to be sole executrix of this my last will---"

Barbara Beath recorded her father's death in her Bible 5 th May 1834. The will was proved by Peter Snyder the 6th of July 1834. No graves have been found for John and Barbara and Barbara does not show up on the 1840 census with any of her children in Ohio. Is it possible that they went back to Virginia to see Christian and Phillip and their families, leaving the will to protect Eve's interest in the small plot of ground and cabin they left behind?

Henry Mumma, b 12 Jan 1784 in Earl twp. Lancaster County Pa. He was the 12 child of John Leonard Mumma, the 9th dhild of the immigrant Leonard, He was baptised in the Muddy Creek Church 12 th April 1784 d 15 April 1843 m Elizabeth Kemper b 28 Sept. 1778. She was dau. of David Kemper and Elizabeth Stump.
